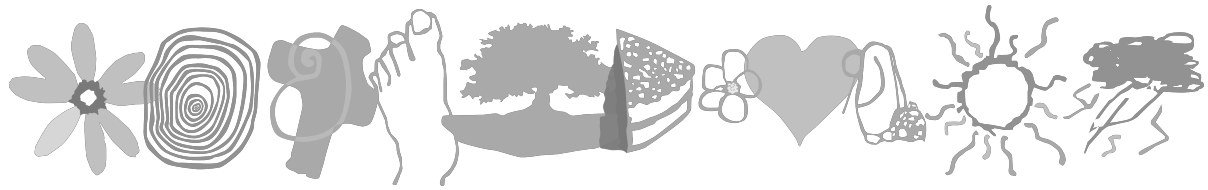

1. You can cancel your Standing Order, donation or Gift Aid declaration at any time. Please inform your bank and let us know.
2. Please notify us if you change your name or address while your Standing Order is in force.
3. Please treat as Gift Aid donations all qualifying gifts of money made from the date of this declaration and in the past four years. I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities (including churches) and Community Amateur Sports Clubs that I donate to will reclaim on my gifts for that tax year. I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify. I understand the charity will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I give. (see overleaf).
If you alter the amount you give, it is not necessary to complete a new gift aid declaration.
4. If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief contact the Parish Office or Gift Aid Officer (John Saville on 01924 255354). Alternatively ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.

Your details may be stored electronically (except for bank details) for administrative purposes and shared with our Gift Aid Officer, John Saville (for the purposes of making Inland Revenue claims). Your details may also be shared with Martin Porritt (01924 258775), who co-ordinates our 'Promise' cards and Envelope Scheme.
