Please note:

A boy should have two godfathers and one godmother, a girl two godmothers and one godfather. Parents may stand as godparents. Ideally, each godparent should be a full communicant member of the Church, and in fact the law of the Church requires this. Only a person who is confirmed can fully make the promise required at baptism of the child and undertake the important duties of helping the child to grow in the Christian faith until he or she is ready to be confirmed. It is appreciated that this does present practical problems but you are asked to try to find at least one confirmed godparent who is a communicant. We look forward to welcoming your child into the church family. Baptism is a wonderful occasion and a spiritual birthday; the beginning of life lived as followers of Jesus Christ.
